

The GEM II is a studio loom made to be very sturdy and portable. It is designed so a weaver can weave at it with a chair. Woven material comes across the weaving area, around the Breast Beam, around the Knee Bar, and down to be wrapped on the Cloth Beam (Green line in photo). This keeps the woven material well above even tall weaver's legs.

The bottom of the 2" thick Breast Beam is 26 1/2" off the floor.

The top of the board the Treadles are attached to is 4" above the floor.

The top of tied up treadles can vary but, about where the Treadle Ties start, the top surface is about 6" above the floor, although generally a weaver would not step this far forward on a treadle.

For the 10 treadles the space width over/between treadles is 4".
